

## **Items to Bring for Tax Return Preparation:**

All taxpayers need to bring item number **1** and **2** below, **plus** all other items which apply to you.

1. $\square$ <b>Photo ID</b> (adults); if married, filing jointly, both spouses must <u>sign</u> return	
2.   Social Security Card for you, spouse, and dependents	
3. □ ITIN (Individual Taxpayer Identification Number) - only for people who do not have a SS# and are <u>not eligible</u> to obtain one; generally applies to resident and non-resident aliens	
4. ☐ Wage statements from all employers (W-2); not pay stubs	
5. $\square$ Interest and Dividend Statements; Investment statements (1099-INT, 1099-DIV)	i
6. $\square$ Retirement Income - IRA and Pension statements (1099-R)	
7. $\square$ Social Security <u>annual</u> statement if receiving social security (SSA-1099)	
8. $\square$ Social Security Disability - if applicable; proof of amount (SSDI and SSI)	
9. □ Other income statements, including unemployment compensation (1099-C, 1099-MISC, W2-G, 1099-G)	
10. $\square$ If Self-employed – <u>tallied</u> record of all gross receipts and expenses	
<ol> <li>Any other tax-related statements received, such as Mortgage Interest Stateme (1098), Tuition Statement (1098-T), and Student Loan Interest (1098-E)</li> </ol>	nt
12. $\square$ Vermont Health Connect statement (1095-A) <b>IF</b> you received health insurance from VHC; other health insurance forms helpful but <u>not required</u> (1095-B/C)	
13. ☐ Health Insurance Exemption Certificate IF you received one from Vermont Health Connect (VHC); or letter from VHC if you are still waiting for certificate	
14. $\square$ Bank routing and account numbers (written), if electing direct deposit	
15. $\square$ Statement from registered daycare provider, if applicable	
16. $\square$ <b>Homestead Declaration</b> - <u>Current</u> Property Tax bill for homeowners	
17.   Renter's Rebate - Original Landlord Certificate (LC-42); OR computer printout with code number if Landlord completed the certificate online	
18.   IF applying for Renter's Rebate or Property Tax Adjustment (aka Prebate), bri taxable & non-taxable income and SS# for everyone who lived with you last ye	_
19. $\square$ Last year's income tax returns can be helpful if available, not required.
